

# Garden Mystery Quilt, block 7

## Materials:

Light cotton backing 10" x 10"

Gray hand dyed wool for watering can 6" x 6 1/2"

Red wool for flowers 1 1/2" x 4"

Pumpkin wool for flowers 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Green wool cut on bias for stems 1 2/4" x 4"

Green wool for leaves 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Off white texture wool for flower centers 2" x 2"

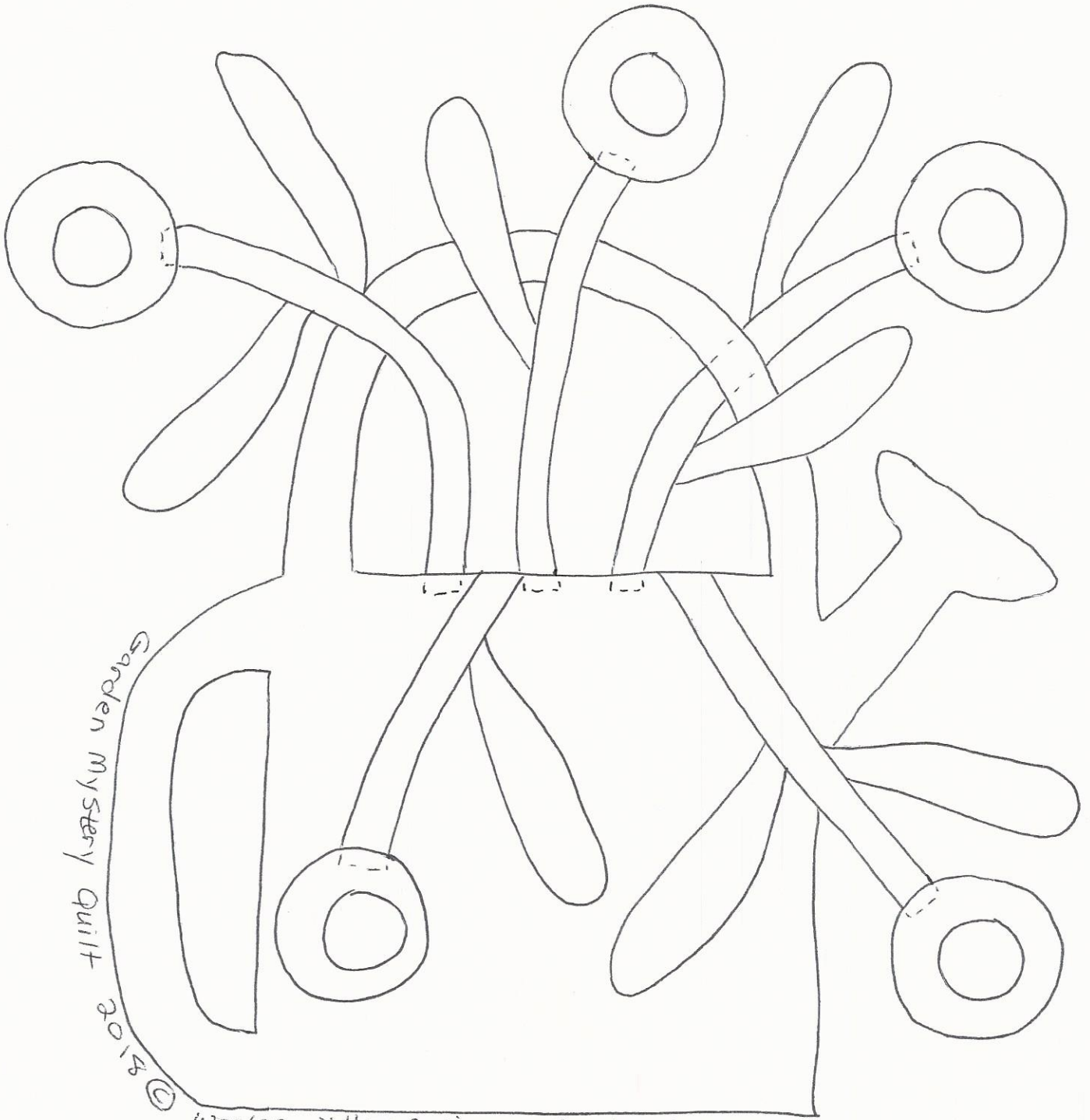
## Instructions:

If using fusible web, you will want to reverse the pattern, if you wish your design to be in the same direction as the photo.

Following your favorite method for wool applique, use the templates provided. If you are using my kit, the wool for the stems is already cut on the bias...so you just need to use your rotary cutter and cut straight 1/4" wide strips, place them where they go and trim off what you don't need. If you are using fusible web, press the web to the wool before you cut it. When you pull off the paper your strips will still curve and bend how you need them to!

Place everything to your background fabric according to the photo. Stitch using your favorite threads and stitches! When complete, press and trim to 9 1/2" square!
