

# Little Wool Sampler

Finishing instructions

## For piecing your quilt you will need:

3/4-1 yard (for mistake room) of fabric for the sashing, borders and binding. I used dark brown linen look cotton.

## For the wool applique you will need:

- Flower 1- 4 1/2" x 6" green for stems and leaves  
1 1/2" x 5 1/2" red for flowers  
1" x 3" pumpkin for flower centers
- Flower 2- 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" green for stems and leaves  
2" x 10" light blue for flowers  
1 1/2" x 5" pumpkin for flower centers
- Flower 3- 3 1/2" x 6" green for stems and leaves  
1 1/2" x 5" pumpkin for flowers  
1 1/2" x 2 1/2" light blue for flower centers
- Flower 4- 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" gold multi plaid for flowers  
1 1/2" x 4 1/2" light tan for flower centers  
4" x 5 1/2" green for stems and leaves
- Flower 5- 4" x 4" green for stems and leaves  
1 1/2" x 7" pumpkin for berries

From the brown fabric, cut two 1 1/2" x WOF strips. From EACH of these strips cut three 6 1/2" strips, for the sash pieces that go between the blocks. What pieces are left will be the long strips between the rows.

Cut three 4 1/2" x WOF strips for the borders....cut one in half at the fold, for each side, and then the two whole pieces will go on the top and bottom.

Cut four 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

Lay out the blocks with the short strips of brown in between and sew together one row at a time. Press the seams toward the brown strip. Next sew the rows together with a long brown strip between the rows. Press the seams toward the brown. Trim after each strip, and make sure the blocks line up from row to row before you sew!

Sew a border strip to each side of the quilt, press seam toward the brown, and trim. Sew a border strip to top and bottom...press and trim.

Using the applique templates provided, and following your favorite applique method... Make four of each flower, and appliqu  in place!

Layer the quilt top with batting and backing, and quilt! I hope you have enjoyed this little project! Thank you! Jeni
